- Clear and informative signage: Are there enough signs to guide users? Are they clear, visible, and informative?
- Trail Difficulty: Does the trail difficulty match the advertised level? Are there any unexpectedly difficult sections?
- Obstacles: Are there any obstacles on the trail that could pose a danger to users? If so, have they been properly marked?
- Maintenance issues: Are there any maintenance issues like eroded paths, fallen trees, or damaged infrastructure that need to be addressed?
- Accessibility: Is the trail accessible for users with different abilities? Are there any sections that might pose a challenge?
- Emergency access: In case of an emergency, can rescue teams access the trail easily? Are there any areas where this might be difficult?
- Trail width: Is the trail wide enough to accommodate the expected number of users?
- User conflicts: Are there any areas where conflicts might occur between different types of users (e.g., hikers and bikers)?
- Natural hazards: Are there any natural hazards like cliffs, rivers, or unstable ground that users should be made aware of?
- Wildlife: Are there any wildlife-related safety considerations that need to be addressed?
- Amenities: Are amenities like restrooms, parking, and water available and in good condition?
