- User Group Identification: Have all potential user groups been identified? This could include hikers, cyclists, horseback riders, bird watchers, etc.
- User Group Needs: Are the needs of each user group understood and accounted for?
- Conflict Zones: Are there known areas of conflict between user groups? Are these areas clearly marked and is there a plan to address these conflicts?
- User Group Separation: Where possible and practical, are separate paths provided for different user groups?
- Signage: Are there clear and visible signs directing user groups to the appropriate paths or usage areas?
- User Group Communication: Are there channels for communication between user groups and the management of the trail?
- Trail Etiquette: Is trail etiquette clearly communicated to all users through signage, brochures, or online information?
- Rules and Regulations: Are there clear rules and regulations that minimize conflicts? Are these rules enforced?
- User Group Representation: Do all user groups feel represented in decisions made about the trail?
- Feedback Mechanism: Is there a mechanism for users to provide feedback or report conflicts?
